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

## Questions and Answers

### *What Can I Do To Prevent Nuisance Service Calls At My House?*

Although some service calls are necessary, there are a few things you can do to save yourself some time and money from a service call.

First, make sure your filter is clean. One of the most common service calls that can be prevented is a dirty filter.

Second, the majority of thermostats take batteries. So take off your thermostat and replace the batteries with new ones to make sure that’s not the problem.

Third, check to make sure the power is on. Reset the power switch on the side of your furnace. This will help reset any “soft faults”. You will still need to schedule a service call to permanently fix the problem, but this will help you schedule at your convenience. It will also prevent an emergency service call after hours or on the weekend.
