Recipe: Chicken Salad by Leslie Beeson


- 1 can of chicken

Questions and Answers

What is a hybrid system?

A hybrid system is the combination of an outdoor heat pump with an indoor gas furnace. In most applications, the hybrid system is much more efficient and cuts down monthly utility bills by about 30% (on average). The heat pump heats the home until the outdoor temperature gets below about 25 degrees. Then gas furnace kicks in as the "backup" heat. This keeps both the electric and gas bills very low.

What is a programmable thermostat?

A programmable thermostat allows you to have the standard functions of a non-programmable thermostat, but also allows you to program different degree settings for different times of the day. For instance, if you typically keep your house at 72 degrees and would like to set it back to 69 degrees in the winter while you're at work, you can. It allows for lower utility bills.
